Commissioner Key/Arrowhead Honor Award: For Commissioners who have completed training and performance requirements. Detailed requirements are listed in the progress record of the *"Leadership Training Committee Guide" No. 34169*, which must be completed by the applicant.

Cub Scouter Award: For Cub Scouters who have completed training and performance requirements and served 2 years at the pack, district or council level. Detailed requirements are listed in progress record of the *"Leadership Training Committee Guide" No. 34169* for the Cub Scouter Award, which must be completed by the applicant.

Cubmaster Award: For Cubmasters who have completed training and performance requirements and served 2 years (1 may be as an Assistant Cubmaster). Detailed requirements are listed in the progress record of the *"Leadership Training Committee Guide" No. 34169* for the Cubmaster Award, which must be completed by the applicant.

Den Leader Award: For Cub Scout Den Leaders who have completed training and performance requirements and served 2 years (1 may be as an Assistant Den Leader). Detailed requirements are listed in the progress record of the *"Leadership Training Committee Guide" No. 34169* for the Den Leader Award, which must be completed by the applicant.

Den Leader Coach Award: For Den Leader Coaches who have completed training and performance requirements and served 2 years. Detailed requirements are listed in the progress record of the *"Leadership Training Committee Guide" No. 34169* for the Den Leader Coach Award, which must be completed by the applicant.

Distinguished Commissioners Service Award: For Commissioners who have completed training and performance requirements and served 5 consecutive. Detailed requirements can be found in the *Commissioner Fieldbook for Unit Service*.

District Award of Merit: Any deserving Scouter who has contributed exceptional leadership abilities and performed service to others beyond their primary registered position. This is the highest award that the district can bestow. Must complete "Nomination for Award of Merit".

Extra Miler Award: For those leader in your unit that have gone the "extra mile" in Scouting. Provide a write-up of accomplishments.

National Camping Award: For Boy Scout Troops where all patrols were represented in 4 short-term and one long-term camp in the past 12 months. Must complete application for "National Camping Award".

Scouter's Key: This award is available for Scoutmasters, Commissioners, Exploring Advisors and District Committee Members who have completed training and performance requirements and have served 3 years. Detailed requirements are listed in the appropriate progress record of the *"Leadership Training Committee Guide" No. 34169*, which must be completed by the applicant.

Scouter's Training Award: This award is available for Boy Scout Leaders, Exploring Leaders and Roundtable Staff who have completed training and performance requirements and served 2 years. Detailed requirements are listed in the appropriate progress record of the *"Leadership Training Committee Guide" No. 34169*, which must be completed by the applicant.

Scoutmaster Award of Merit: For Scoutmasters who have completed training and performance requirements and served 18 months. Nominated by Troop Committee Chair on Application #58-413 for the National Eagle Scout Association Scoutmaster Award of Merit.

Spouse Award: This award recognizes a volunteer's time given "away from family or spouse" for the benefit of Scouting. Any Scouter may nominate a spouse (or significant other) for this award.

Summertime Pack Award: For Cub Scout Packs where a monthly activity was planned and conducted for June, July and August. Must complete application for "Summertime Pack Award".

Tiger Cub Den Leader Award: For Tiger Cub Den Leaders who have completed training and performance requirements and served 1 years. Detailed requirements are listed in the progress record for the Tiger Cub Den Leader Award, which must be completed by the applicant.

Veteran's Award: For all registered adults, these awards recognize tenure in Scouting. Youth and adult tenure can be combined and the awards are available in 5-year increments. The award includes a pin that can be worn on civilian clothing.

Webelos Den Leader Award: For Webelos Den Leaders who have completed training and performance requirements and served 2 years (1 may be as an Assistant Webelos Den Leader). Detailed requirements are listed in the progress record for the Webelos Den Leader Award of the *"Leadership Training Committee Guide" No. 34169*, which must be completed by the applicant.
