# Cub Annapolis Rules

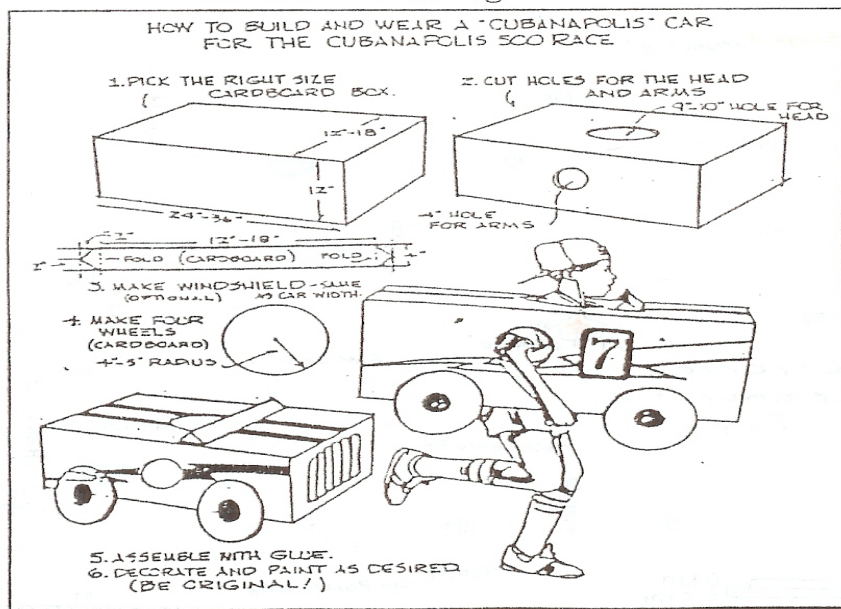
1. Each scout should make his own cardboard box car that he wears. He can decorate it as he wishes -- family members are allowed to help.
2. Each team is composed of:
  - The "Driver" (Cub Scout)
  - The "Pit Crew" (2 or 3 or more family members)
3. The driver must wear a pair of lace-up shoes with socks. **NO SLIP ON SHOES!** They must Tie!
4. Each heat consists of 4 laps, and each driver must make 3 pit stops during the first 3 laps. During the pit stop, the crew must do one of the following:
  - Lap 1: Change tires (remove shoes, turn socks inside out, replace and retie shoes)
  - Lap 2: Refuel (driver drinks four ounces of liquid through a straw)
  - Lap 3: Clean windshield (squirt water onto goggles and wipe with towel)
  - Lap 4: RUN as fast as you can!

## THE SCOUT SHOULD BRING:

- Cardboard Cubannapolis car
- Tie shoes and socks
- Cool Goggles
- Repair supplies (tape, stapler, etc)
- A Hard Working Pit Crew!!

## COUNCIL WILL FURNISH:

- Refueling liquid (gatorade)
- Straws for refueling
- Squirt bottles
