

THE WILLIAM H. SPURGEON III AWARD

1. Standards of Eligibility

- A. Awarded annually for noteworthy volunteer services of *exceptional* character to young people through the *Explorer program*.
- B. Is awarded to an adult, 21 years of age or older. Maybe awarded to a currently registered Explorer volunteer with a reasonable amount of service time or a business, professional, or community leader whose activities have supported Exploring.
- C. On an annual basis, a Council Awards Committee is formed, composed of *three or more* members who consider and evaluate each nomination before making their selection/s.
- D. No member of the Committee may be considered for the award in the same year.
- E. All nominations must be certified on the attached form by the Committee Chair.
- F. It is the option of the Awards Committee *NOT* to take advantage of the maximum number of awards unless there are well qualified nominations up to that number.

2. Number of Awards Available Annually

The Council is entitled to present up to 3 awards, but is not required to award all three.

3. Approval of Recipients

By-dates, shown on the nomination form, will be adhered to. The Awards Committee, after making their selection/s, forwards the selected nomination forms to the Council Service Center. A review is made and awards are ordered from the National Supply Center.

4. Award of Merit Presentation

The William H. Spurgeon III Award is presented at the Council Recognition Dinner.
