

The Trainer's EDGE

The Trainer's EDGE is the BSA's "train the trainer" course. This course is for all council, district, troop, crew and pack trainers. It is also meant to supplement the practice offered through Wood Badge and NYLT staff development.

This course is intended to "train the trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media. Trainers should know that only practice can polish your presentation skills. Much the course is built on learner participation, and **participants will be expected, between the two evenings, to prepare a 10 minute presentation on a Scouting topic.** A Scout leader uniform is appropriate wear, if you have one, but it's not required (some participants will be coming straight from work). If you want to bring some take-out dinner to the session, that's fine, too.
