REQUIRED AT CHECK-IN

- 1) Scouts must review the merit badge requirements and complete all prerequisites below to successfully "explain," "tell," "show," "demonstrate" and therefore complete this merit badge.
- 2) Completed Annual Health and Medical Forms (parts A, B1, B2) at check-in.
- 3) Signed merit badge blue card turned in at check-in. Unit leader signature required. \$5 fee for VHC to provide a blue card and \$10 fee to replace lost blue cards.

- ④ Complete research for Requirement #8. Be prepared to discuss in class.
