

# Additional information for CVO groups

1. Verdugo Oaks has a public trailhead located across camp that is always open to the general public. Walk in public access must be maintained.
2. As mandated by the US Forest Service all vehicles of Verdugo Oaks clients must be parked facing out and close together. If necessary, you must station a parking attendant to assist your group with proper parking. No CVO guest may park in or around the US Forest Service Compound and State of California Fire Station. All vehicles must have a CVO parking permit in their windshield. The Forest Ranger WILL issue tickets and then tow if vehicles are not parked correctly.
3. If your unit plugs a toilet then your unit is responsible for clearing it. Plungers are located at every rest room. If you are not able to clear it please notify campmaster
4. ANY snake in camp must be reported to campmaster. DO NOT KILL IT. Post a guard to watch snake and get the campmaster.
5. Keep all campers out of flagged areas and corporate area behind dining hall
