

## CAMP VERDUGO OAKS POOL RULES

A Scout unit must follow all policies and procedures as outlined on BSA Safe Swim Defense. This certification must be shown to the campmaster when requesting use of the pool.

All non-BSA Scout units must have a certified Lifeguard and that certification must be shown to campmaster before pool will be allowed to operate. Lifeguard must be in the pool area when pool is in operation. Camp Verdugo Oaks does not supplied qualified lifeguards. Except in an emergency the lifeguard and their spotters may not be in the water.

1. To maintain a clean swimming pool we ask that all swimmers shower with the cloths they will be wearing before entering the pool.
2. Thank you for using the bathrooms for bodily functions while using the pool.
3. Please only use the pool safety equipment as needed for emergencies only. They are NOT TOYS.
4. Running, pushing or horseplay on the deck will result in the loss of pool privileges.
5. Please be courtesy to other swimmers.
6. Do not dive into the pool between the 4' and 6' markers.
7. Infants must be accompanied by their parent at all times. Please no diapers in the pool.
8. Please wear your hair up if possible. No metal bobby pins
9. Appropriate attire is required in pool area.
  - a. Swimsuits only. No underwear under suits or shorts
  - b. Hemmed shorts, no cut offs
  - c. If you wear it in the water, shower in it
  - d. Wear closed toes shoes to the pool area.
10. No food in the pool area
11. No glass in the pool area.
12. You may only enter from east gate next to pool house rest rooms

If you have any questions or concerns at the pool please notify campmaster right away. If there is any type of emergency at the pool the campmaster must be notified immediately.
